Common Language January 19th, 2022

Language Justice April 12th, 2022 or April 14th, 2022

The workshop introduces participants to interpretation skills with a foundation in principles of equity and inclusion. The workshop includes skill-building in consecutive & simultaneous interpretation, ethical issues, the interpreter's role, language, power, social justice, and creating an inclusive multilingual space.
